

Application Checklist

An application to the Joint PhD Program is considered complete when the following items are submitted:

- The **online application** form through the Joint PhD Website.
- ➤ The **application fee** of \$125.00 (Canadian) paid online through the Joint PhD website at time of applying.
- A copy of all unofficial transcripts (including proof of degree(s) completed) to be uploaded to the application portal. Note: If the transript is not in English, a notrarized translation is required.

Evidence of research competence usually demonstrated by a Master's thesis, those who have not completed a thesis must submit evidence of equivalent research capability.

English Language Proficiency:

A minimum score of 7.0 on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS), with no individual sub-category score less than 6.5.

- A minimum score of 100 on the Internet Based Test (iBT) version of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), including a minimum score of 27 in the Written component and a minimum score of 27 in the Reading component.
- A minimum score of 60 (Brock & Lakehead University) and 70 (University of Windsor) on the Canadian Academic English Language (CAEL) examination.

ALL application documents must be received by the Office of the Secretariat no later than **November 15.**
